Donors view comprehensive student information including educational needs and verified documents. Personal details are blurred for privacy whilst maintaining transparency.

Complete Tracking

All payment receipts are uploaded to student profiles. Updates section displays marksheets, performance reports, and achievements for continuous monitoring.

Performance Standards

Support continues only for hardworking, committed students. Failure to maintain expected standards results in discontinued sponsorship and profile removal.

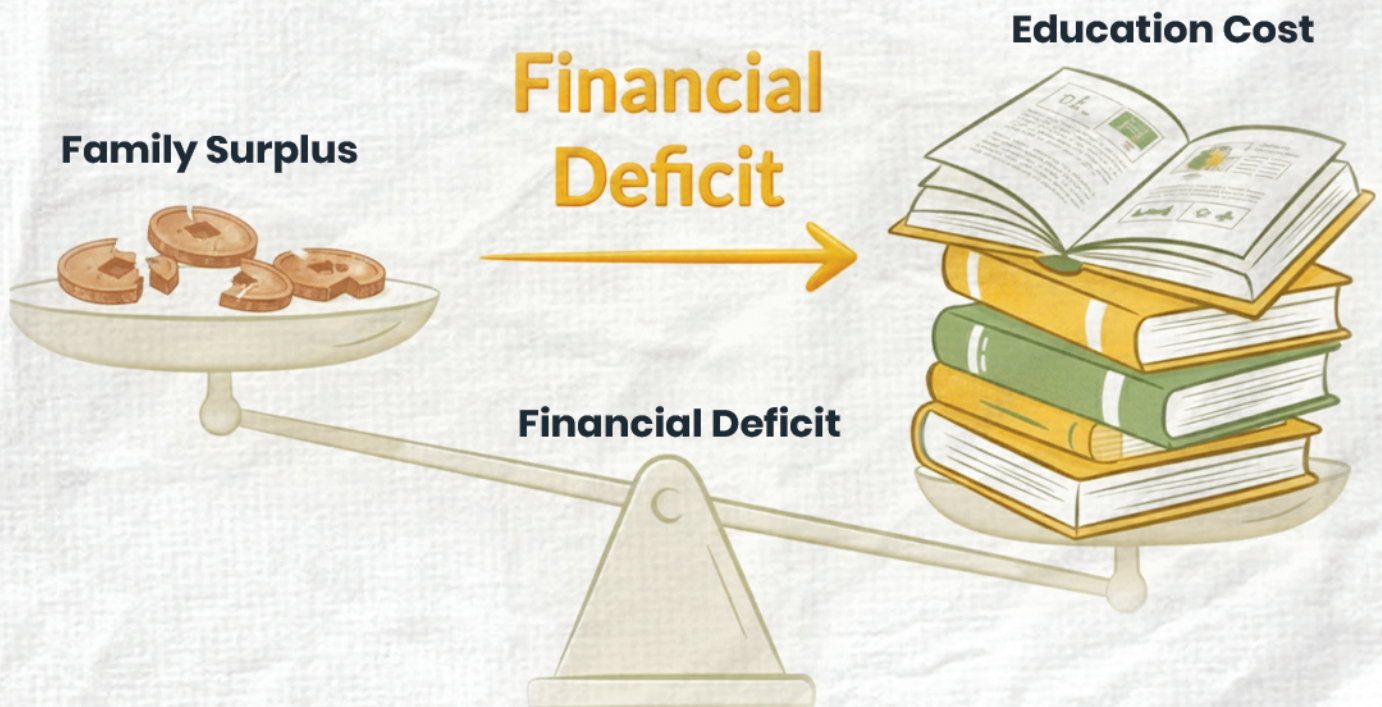


1 PILLAR

Financial Need Assessment

Calculating the Real Financial Deficit

We verify total family income, deduct essential household expenses, and review liquid assets against the total cost of education. A mandatory home visit validates all information.



$$\text{Financial Deficit} = (\text{Total Family Income} - \text{Total Essential Family Expenses}) - \text{Total Cost of Education}$$



Loan-First Policy:

For higher studies, we guide students to secure available education loans first. Scholarships cover the remaining gap.



Shared Responsibility:

The family must contribute their available surplus, ensuring they are partners in the student's education.



Legal Accountability:

The family signs a legal declaration confirming all financial information is true. Misrepresentation can lead to legal recovery of the scholarship amount.

Exclusion Criteria:** We do not provide scholarships to students in private schools/colleges on paid-seat or management-quota basis.



2 PILLAR

Persistence & Value Discipline

(The “Gita Test”)

This pillar evaluates sincerity, discipline, and sustained effort. Hindu students memorise one Bhagavad Gita chapter in any language within specified timeframe, demonstrating dedication and commitment essential for academic success.

1 Why Memorisation?

Requires continuous practice and genuine hard work. Cannot be achieved through shortcuts, providing clear, fair, measurable assessment.

2 Why the Gita?

Students naturally absorb teachings strengthening emotional resilience, mental clarity, and ability to handle academic pressure effectively.

3 Character Building

Teaches values, responsibility, and character—aligning with our vision of helping shape good human beings through education.

*A separate value-based discipline activity for non-Hindu students is currently being developed to ensure fairness, inclusivity, and equal opportunity for all.



3 PILLAR

Past Academic Performance

This pillar evaluates the student's academic journey over the past two years, with emphasis on consistency and improvement, not just high marks.



Marksheet Verification

Cross-verify marksheets directly with the school to ensure authenticity.



Teacher Feedback

Obtain feedback on attendance, discipline, and overall conduct from teachers.



Commitment Assessment

Identify students demonstrating genuine commitment, responsibility, and steady academic effort.

4 PILLAR Cognitive Ability (IQ Testing)

This places them in the High Average to Superior intelligence range (top 20% of the population), indicating strong reasoning, learning capacity, and problem-solving skills.

Our system reduces personal opinions and avoids bias. All decisions based on clear, verifiable data.

02

Inspired by Bhagavad Gita (17:22): donation without identifying right candidate becomes Tamasik in nature.

03

Better to miss few deserving students than support someone not truly deserving. This protects donor trust.

We acknowledge our criteria may be strict. However, when trust is assured, more donors come forward —and more deserving students benefit. We also understand that academic ability and IQ alone do not define success in life. As the Foundation grows, we aim to support larger numbers of deserving students..

STUDENT FUNDING POLICY

01 Eligibility

We support students studying Class 8. Private school management quota or paid seats are not eligible.

02 Coverage

We fund tuition fees, coaching, books, hostel, meals, and academic requirements through direct institutional payments.

03 Other Support

We verify and adjust any NGO support or government scholarships whilst calculating the student's financial deficit.

04 Higher Education

Loan-first approach. We assist in securing education loans and cover remaining expenses if needed.

05 Continued Support

Support continues only with maintained academic performance, discipline, and financial need. Otherwise, sponsorship may be discontinued.

Students and parents must sign consent and legal declarations confirming accuracy of information. Any misrepresentation may lead to immediate termination and legal recovery.

ONLINE APPLICATION

Students submit application and documents through portal. Volunteers assist if needed.

02

DOCUMENT CHECK

Verify all information for accuracy, authenticity, and completeness.

03

DISCIPLINE TEST

Students appear for persistence and value-based discipline assessment.

04

ACADEMIC CHECK

Confirm marks, attendance, and behaviour with school or college.

05

COST VERIFICATION

Verify full cost of student's education requirements.



HOW WE WORK

FINANCIAL DEFICIT

Assess income, expenses, and details to calculate actual financial deficit.

06

IQ TEST

Standard IQ test supervised by clinical psychologist.

07

PROFILE LISTING

Eligible students listed on website for donor selection.

08

SCHOLARSHIP SUPPORT

Support provided based on donor choice and final approval.e.

09

PERIODIC REVIEW

Each supported student reviewed periodically to ensure continued eligibility.
